

## Application Deadlines | 2018-2019 School Year

### Current Families

January 30, 2018	Sibling applications and non-refundable re-enrollment fees due (\$700, \$200 off if turned in by Jan. 30th)
February 23, 2018	Tuition assistance applications due <b>Qualified siblings</b> of Providence students in good standing receive priority when their applications and required forms are received by the due dates

### Prospective Families

February 23, 2018	New family applications and non-refundable application fees of \$100 are due <b>Priority consideration</b> is given to prospective families who submit complete applications on or before February 23, 2018 Applications received after this date will be considered as openings become available

### Tuition Assistance

Providence is committed to providing need-based tuition assistance for those who otherwise would not be able to benefit from a Providence education. Tuition assistance applications are processed by a third party, FAST Grant & Aid Assessment. These applications are processed concurrently with the applications for admission and all financial information is kept strictly confidential. Admission decisions at Providence are made on a need-blind basis and are not impacted by any request for tuition assistance. **March 30, 2018 is the deadline for tuition assistance applications for new students.**

### Admissions Requirements

- Submit recommendation forms to the applicant's current teacher(s) and administrators. These forms, along with school records, should be mailed from the applicant's current school directly to the Admissions Office at Providence.
- After receiving the completed application and fee, parents will be contacted to schedule a date for student assessments (grades Br-12).
- Applicants for grades 7-12 must complete the Student Questionnaire.

### Interviews

Parents will be scheduled for an interview. Students applying for grades 7-12 will also be interviewed. We encourage both parents to become familiar with classical Christian education. Prior to the interview parents are required to read "Letter to Parents" from Wisdom & Eloquence by Littlejohn & Evans.

### Decisions

After interviews and testing have been completed and all application forms are received and reviewed, the Admissions Committee will render decisions. Parents will be notified, and if an offer is made an enrollment agreement will be sent.
